frustrated at him at times but she knows its always for the best.


She played for keystone stingers and guest played for PA Ballhawks the following year playing over 230 games that year. She loved every moment of it.





She has attended the All American games and ended the weekend with an Elite invitation to attend games across the US. She had also attended a CSB event (college

















