You will always find her roaming around the gym talking to her friends and working hard. She will always be lending a hand any coach that needs to help.



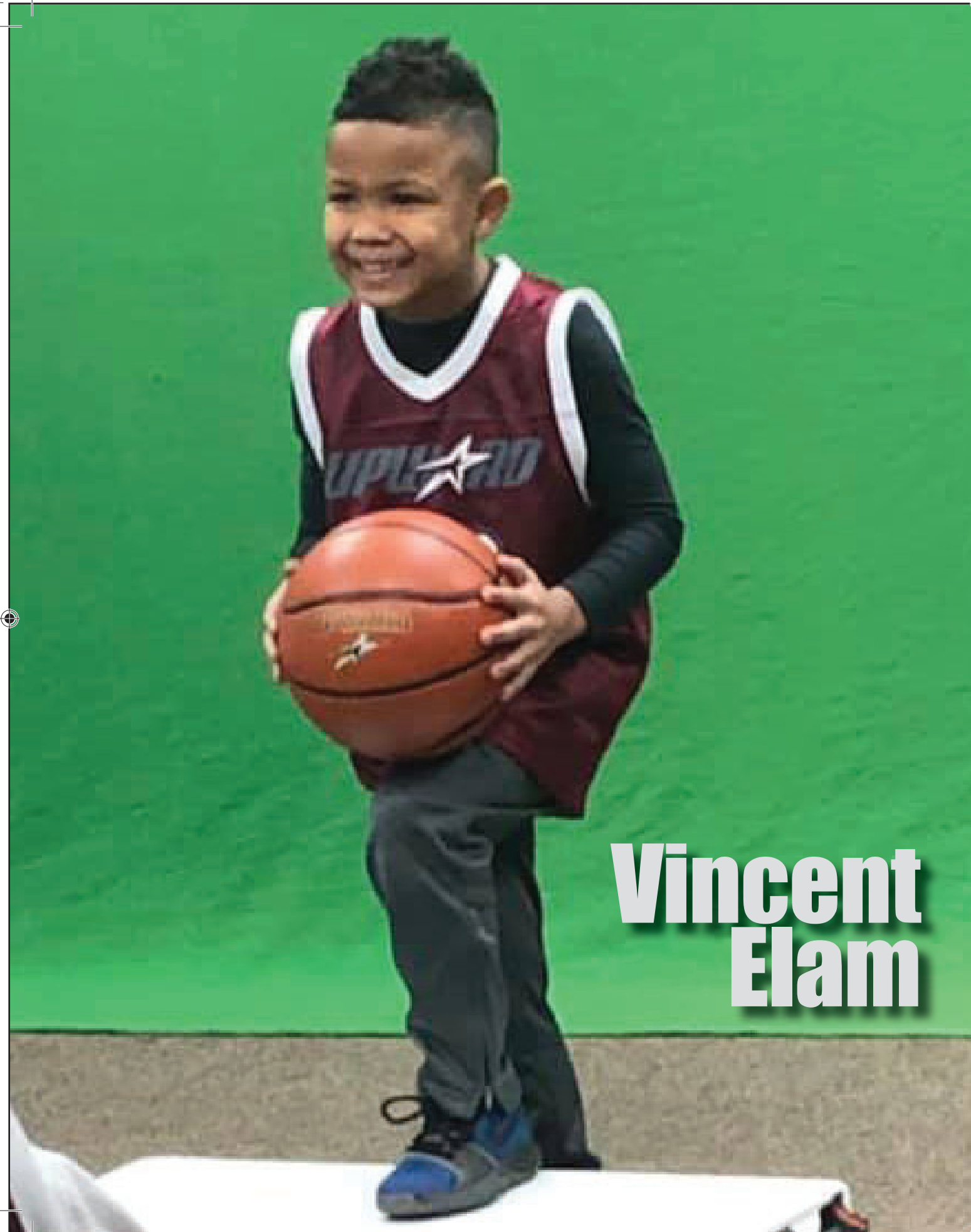

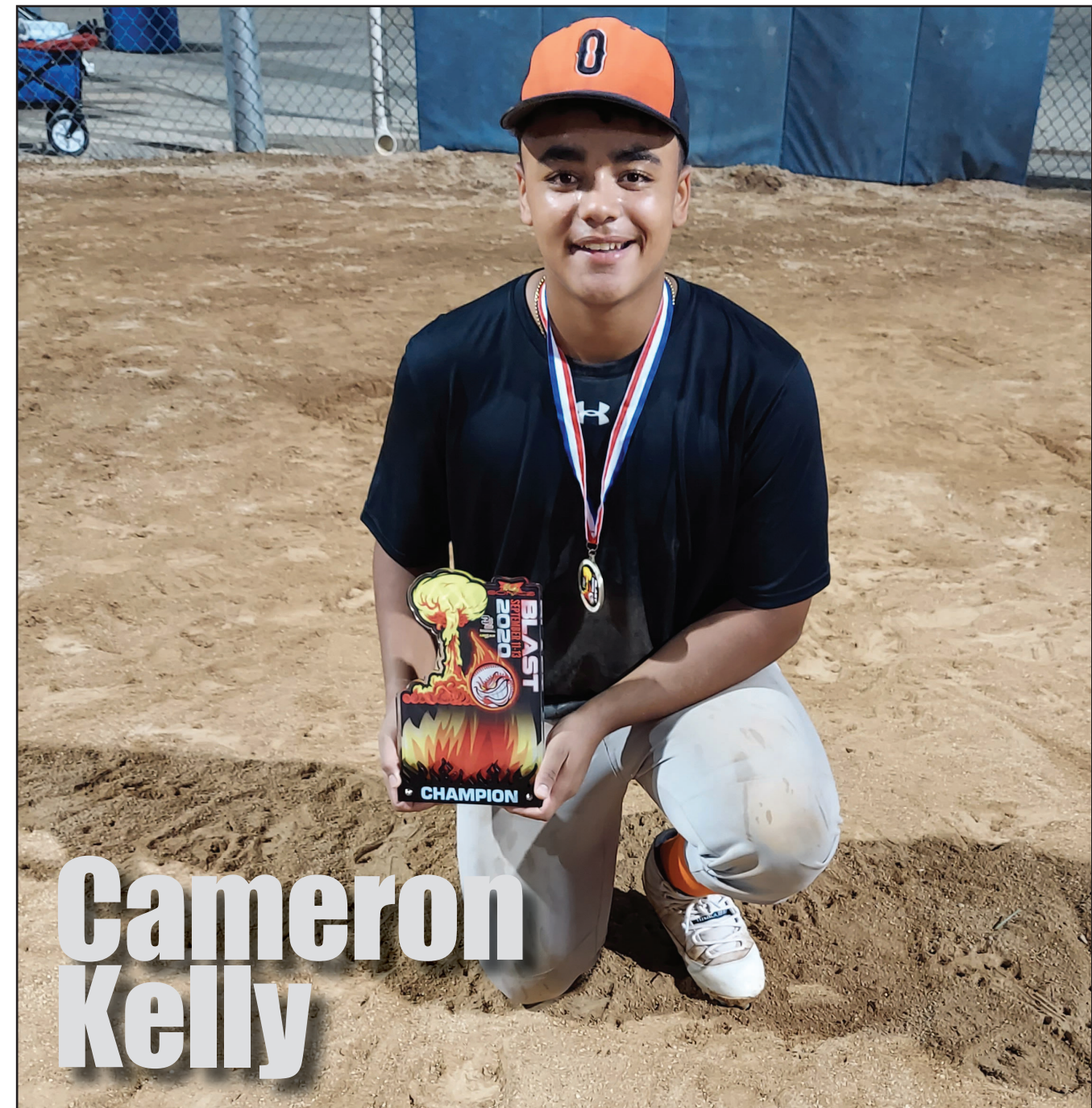

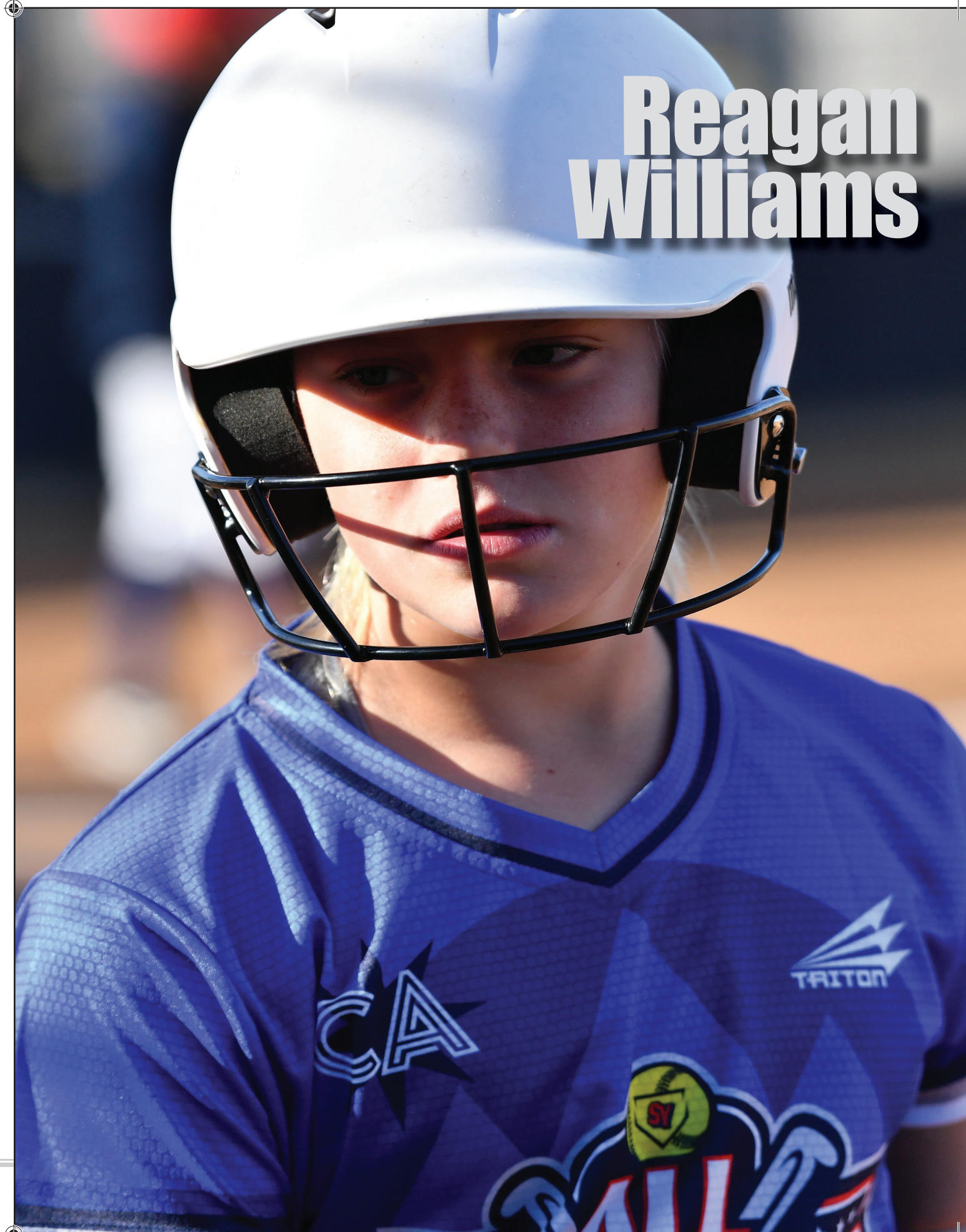


Dylan Ramsey

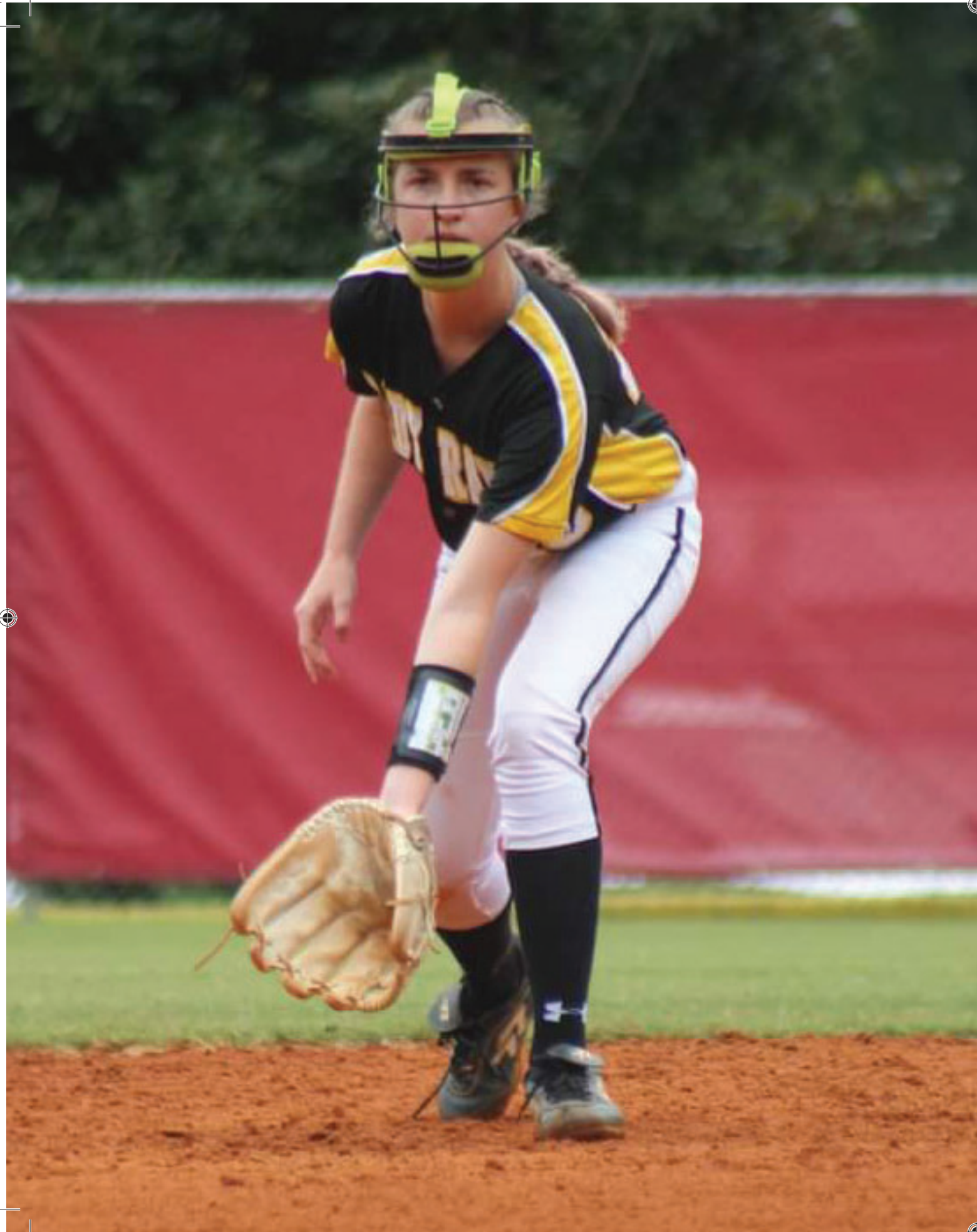


Lindsey Mainor

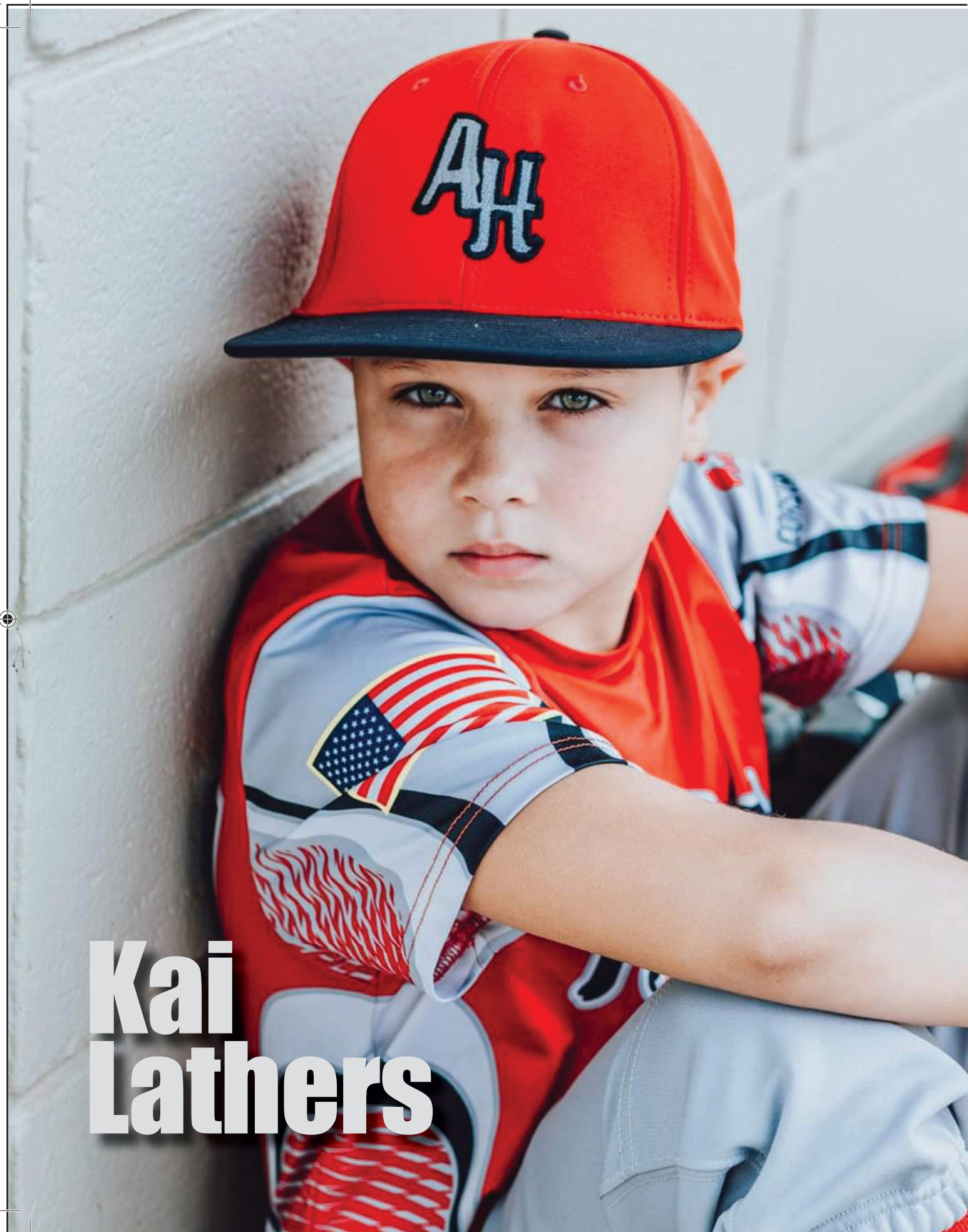

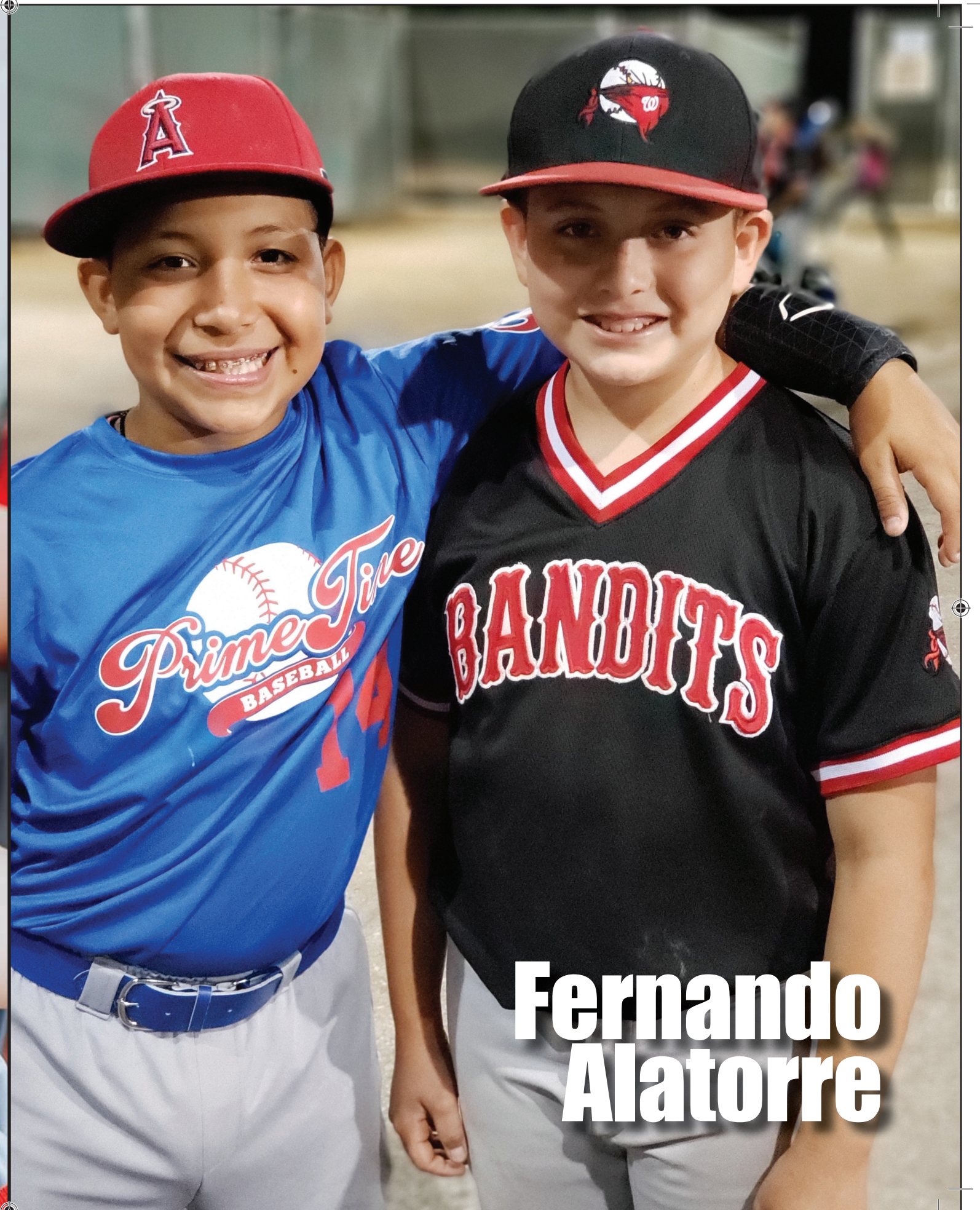

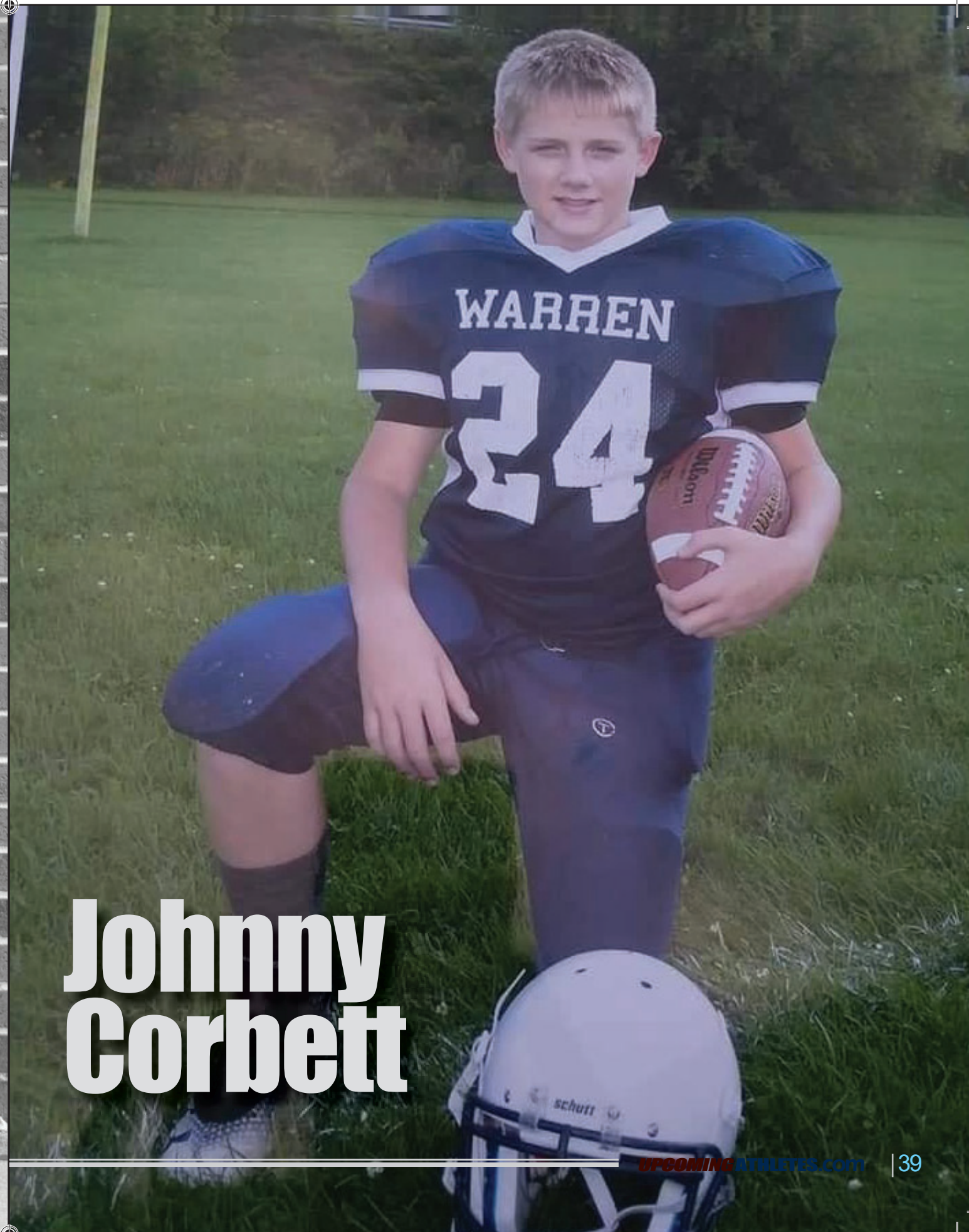

Johnny Corbett

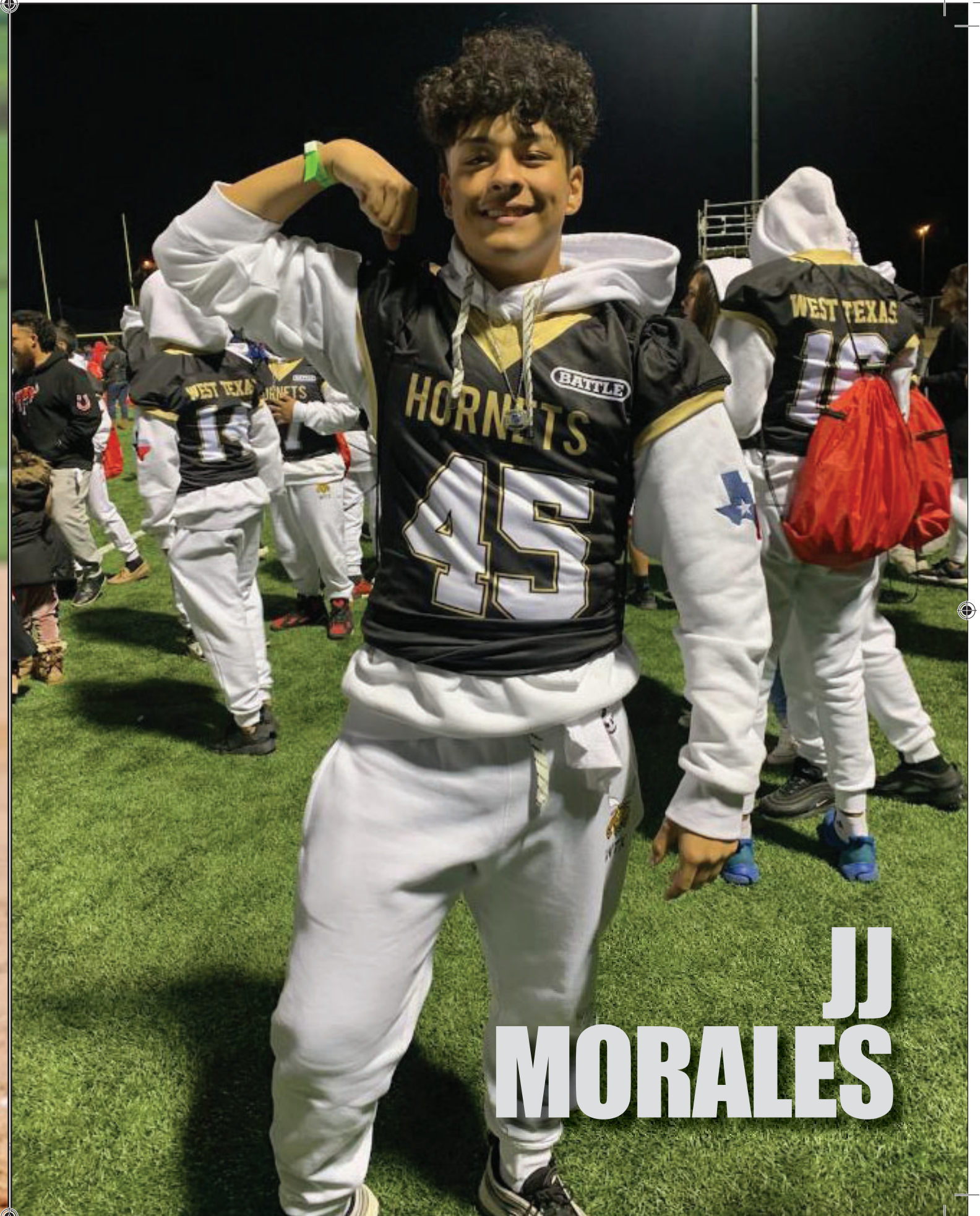

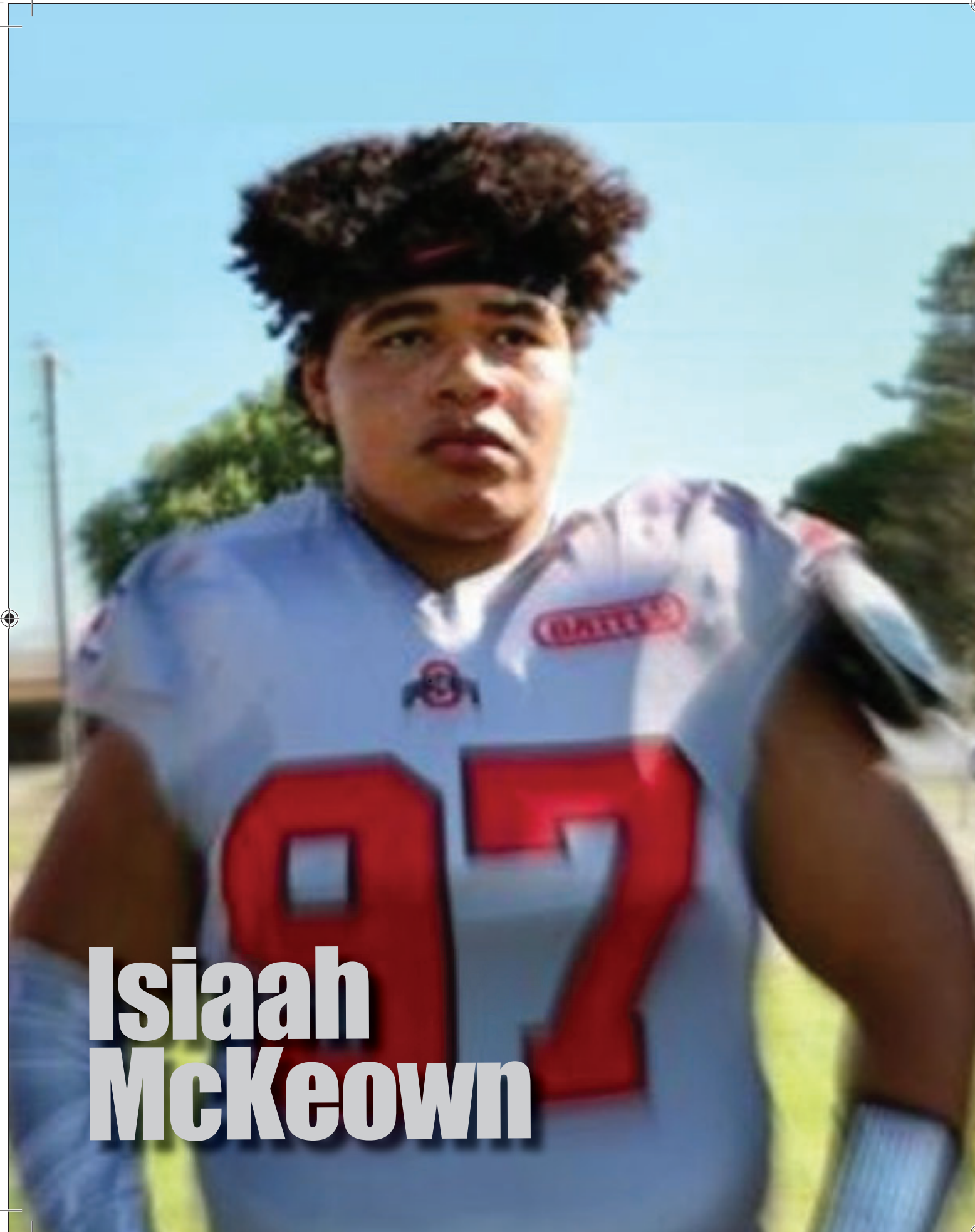

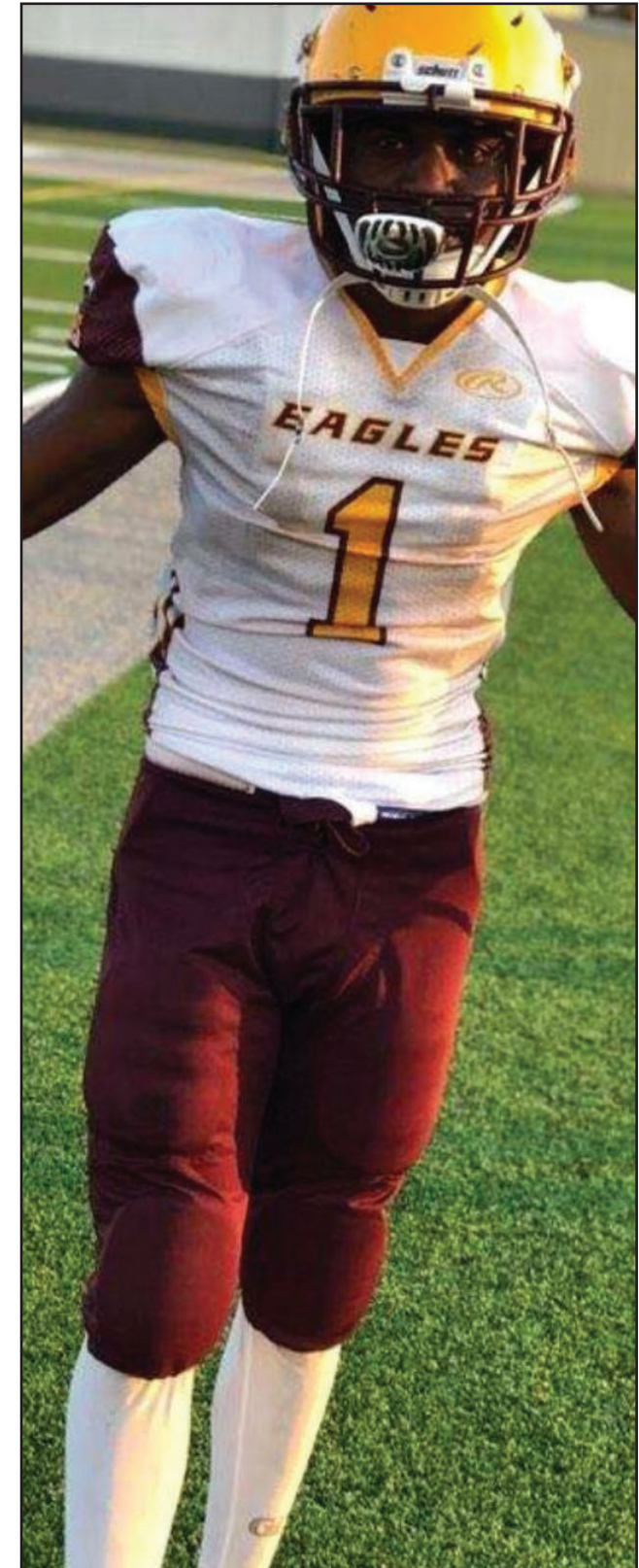
