Tristyn Raley

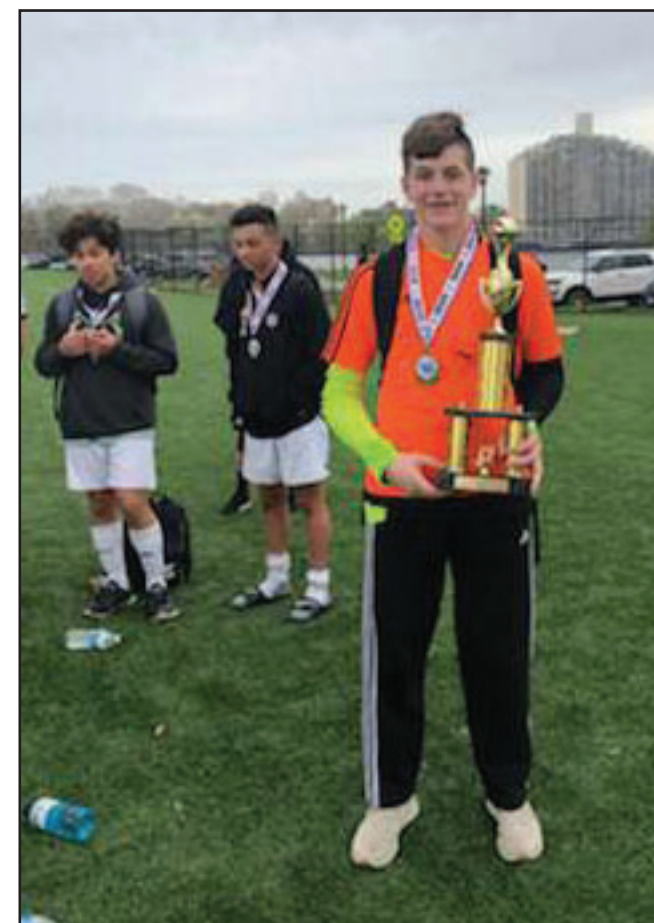
