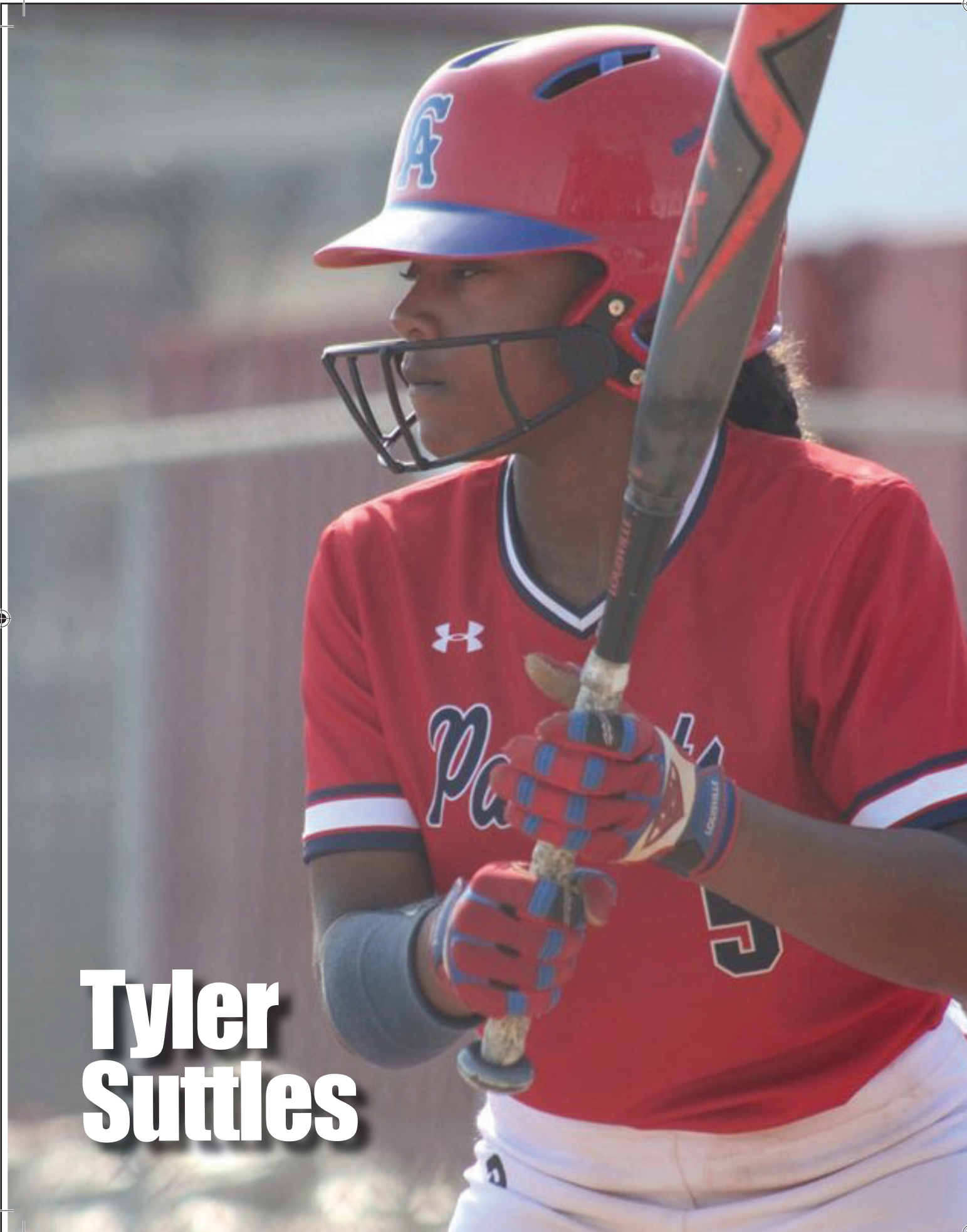
ariels and back handsprings. She is small framed but she is a powerhouse. Her goal is to compete at the collegiate level.

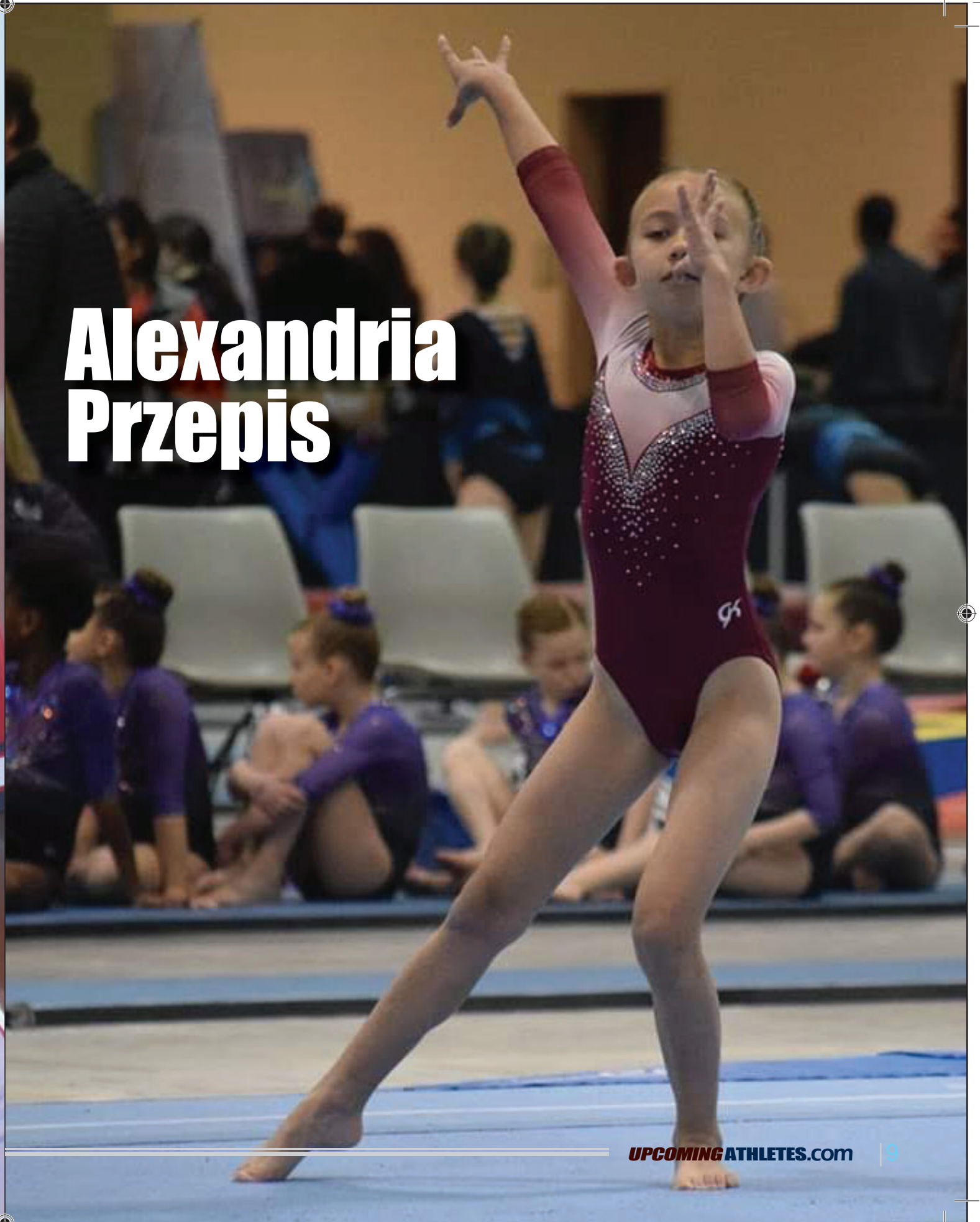

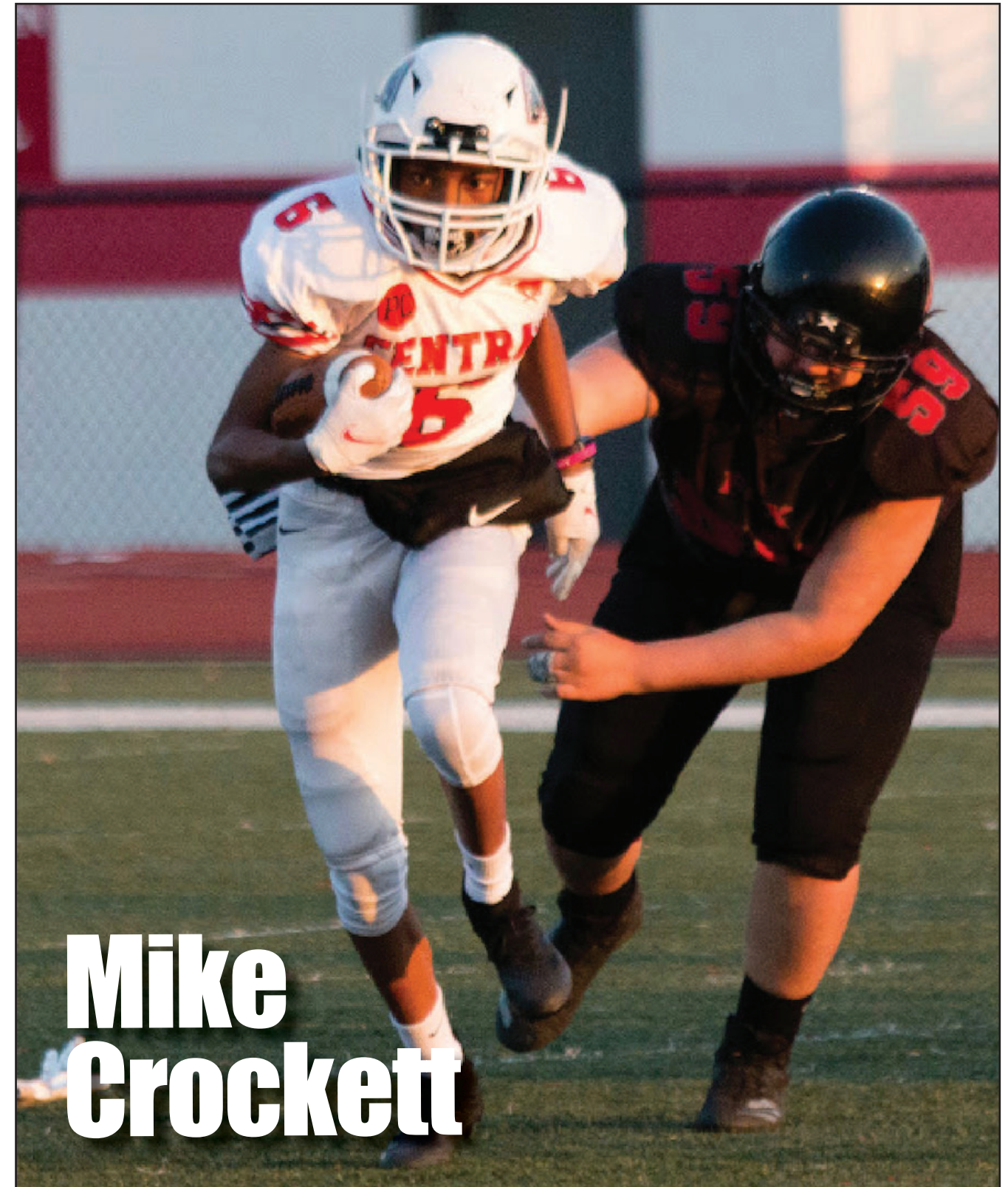


Brayden Singleton

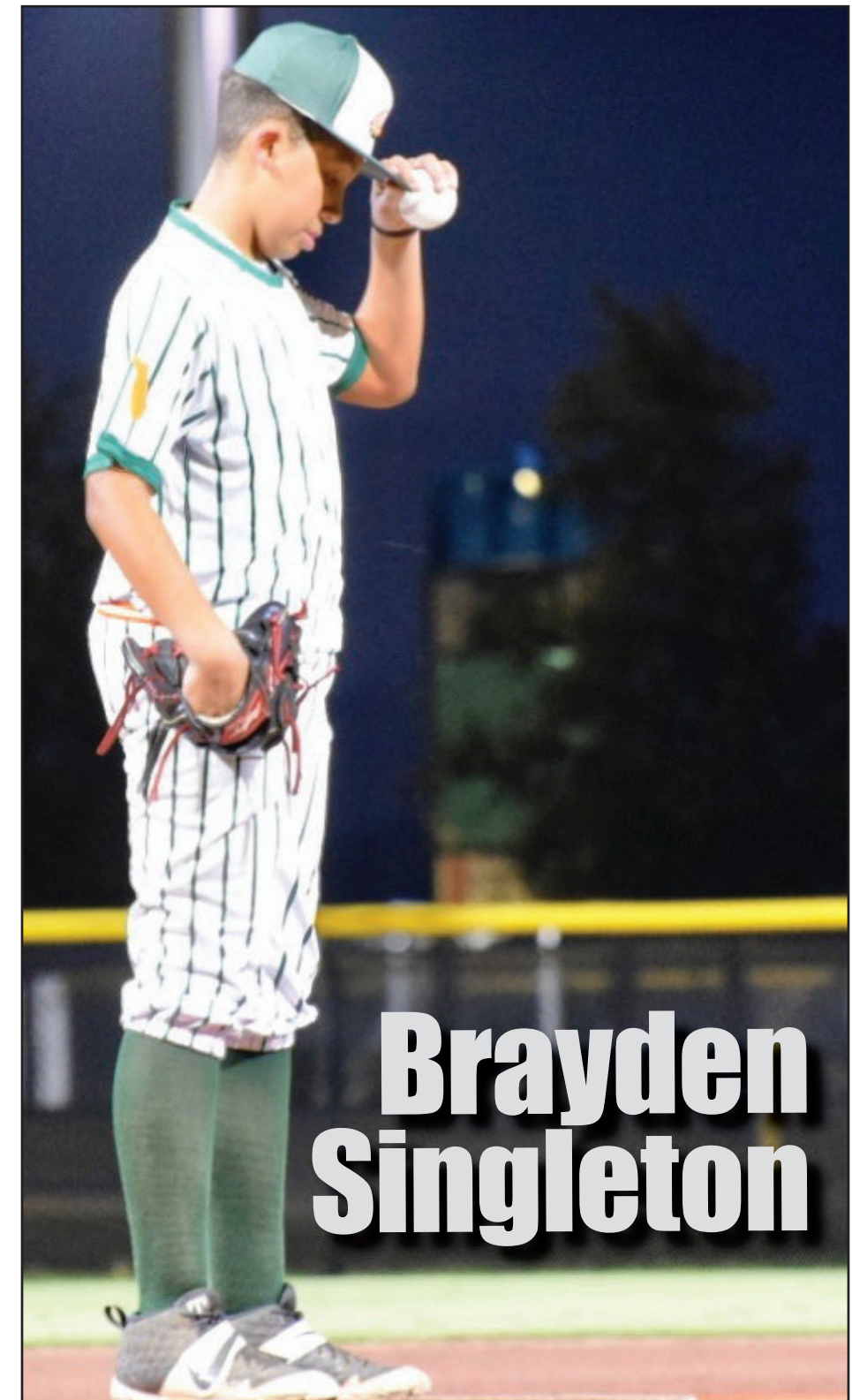


**Mike

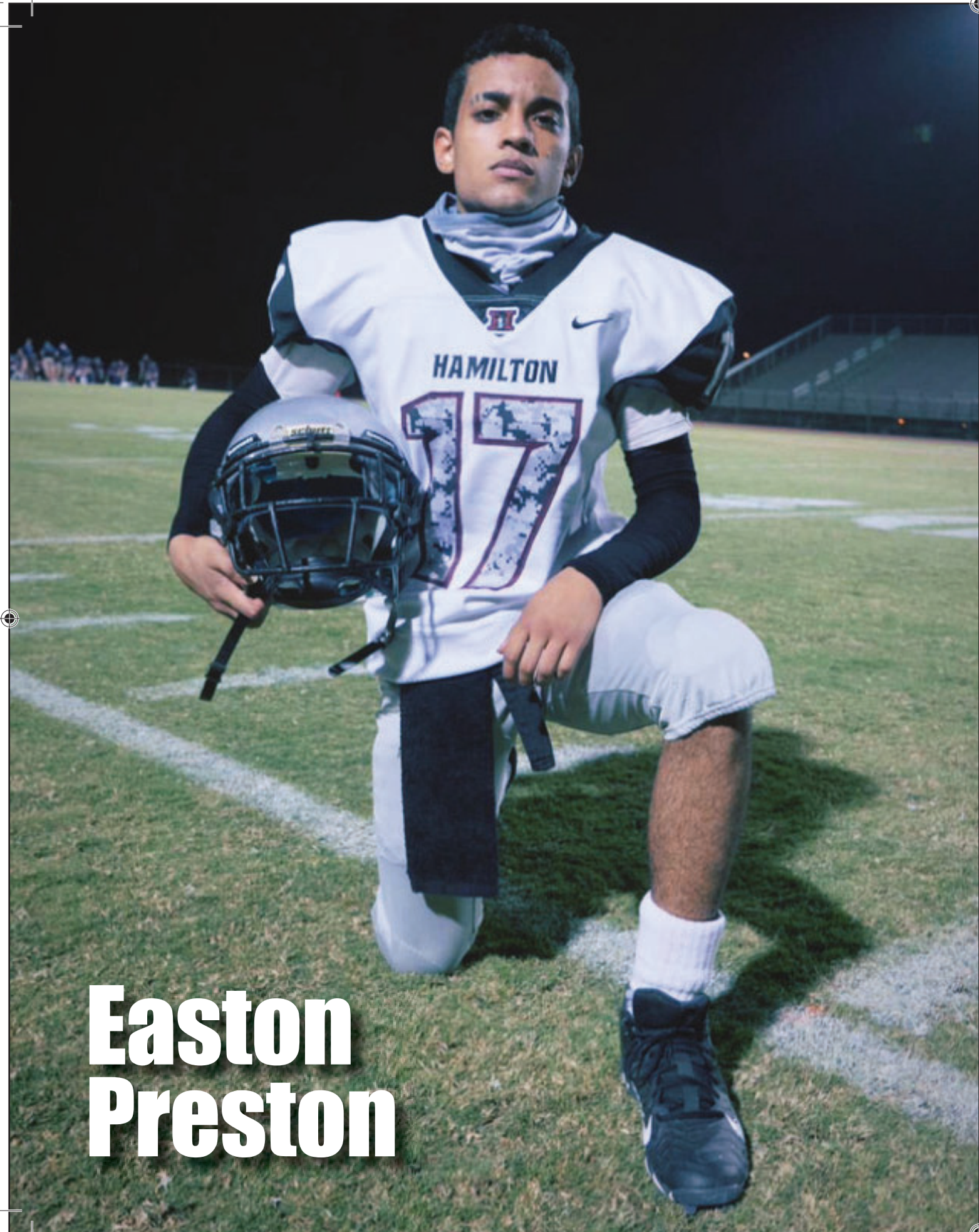

He turned down offers to play for Chicago Fire Academy to play for Lake Forest Academy honoring his scholarship.

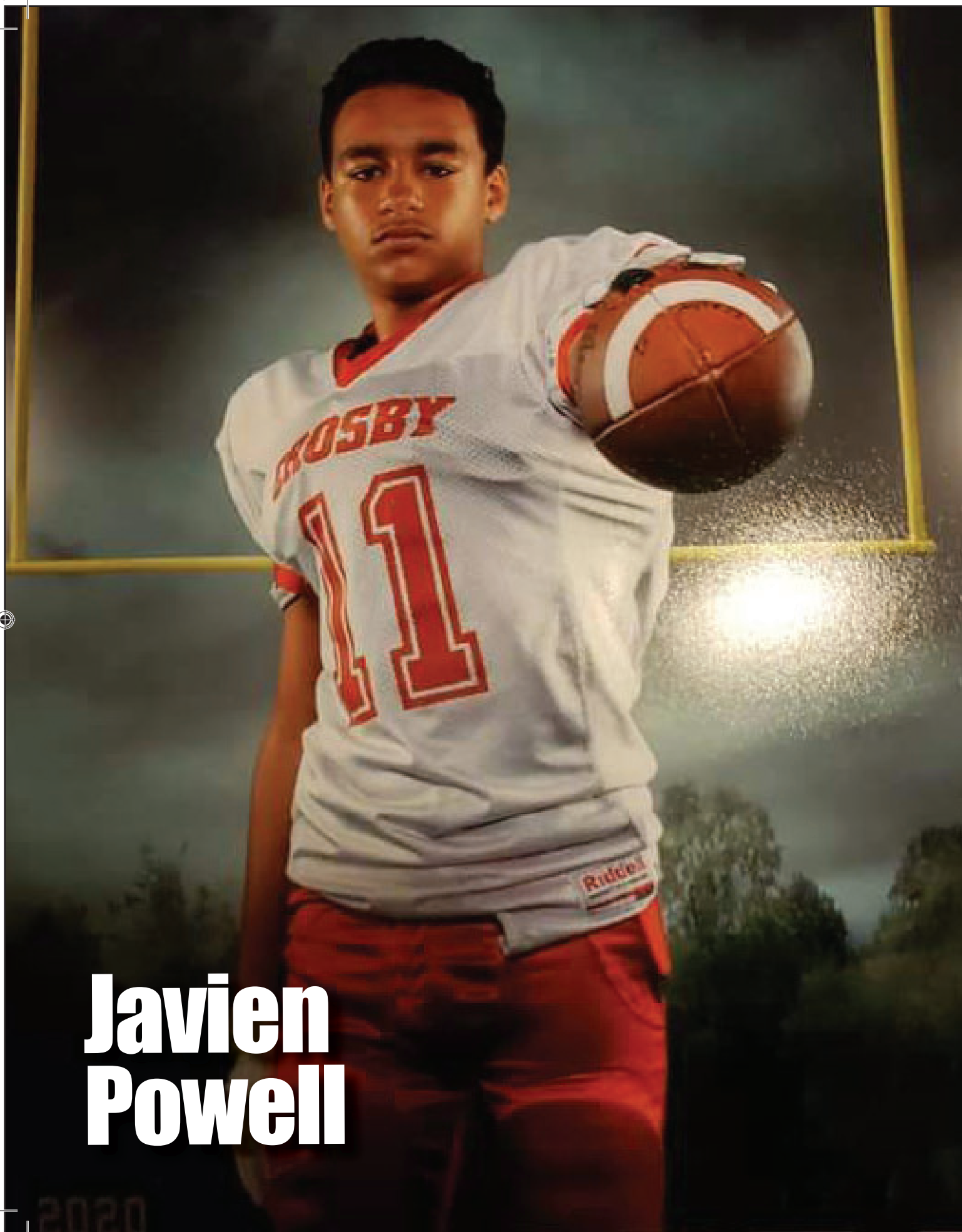
Luis suffered minor but nagging injuries in HS that hurt his chances of playing D1 but is 100% now.

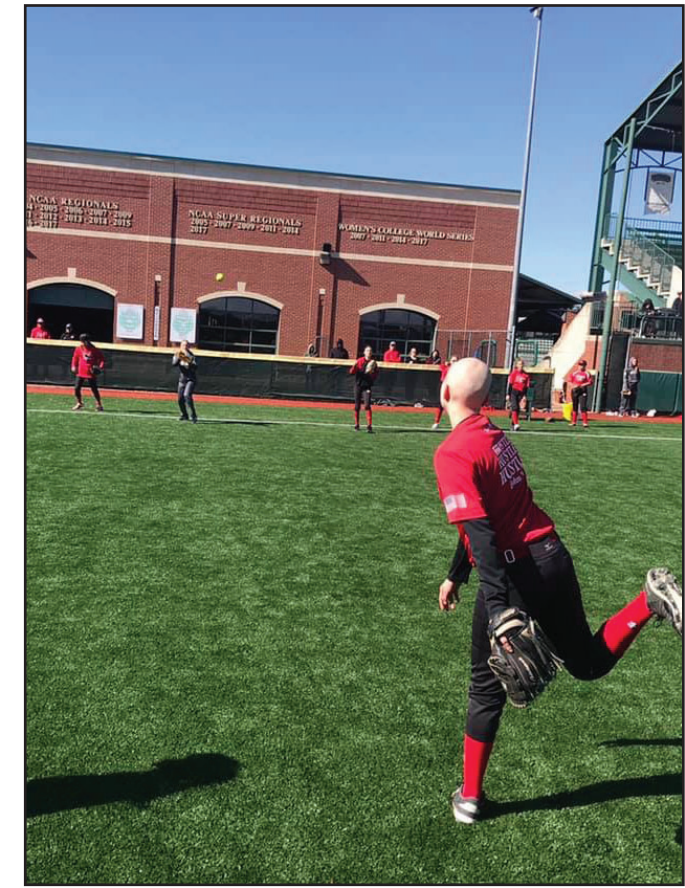

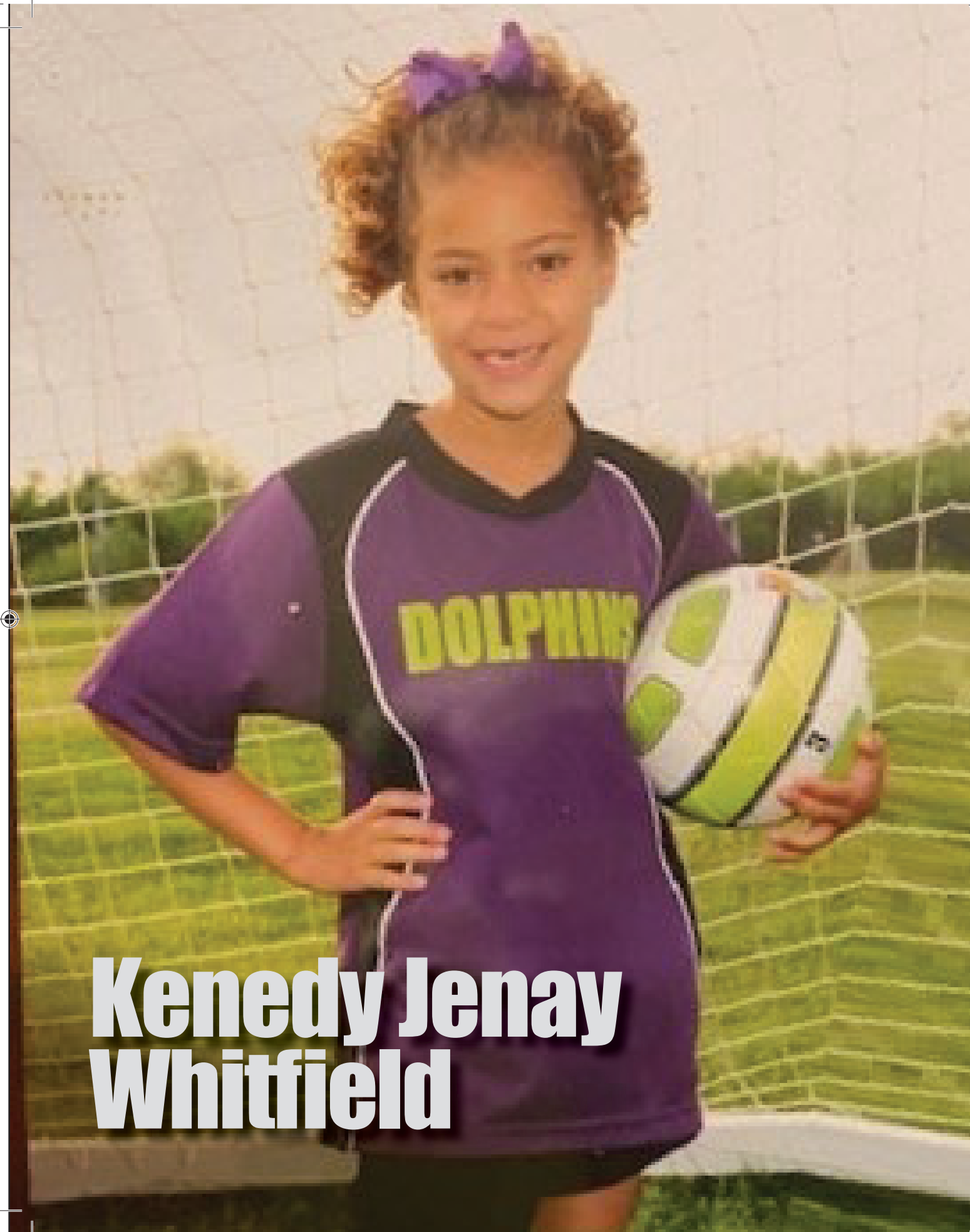
