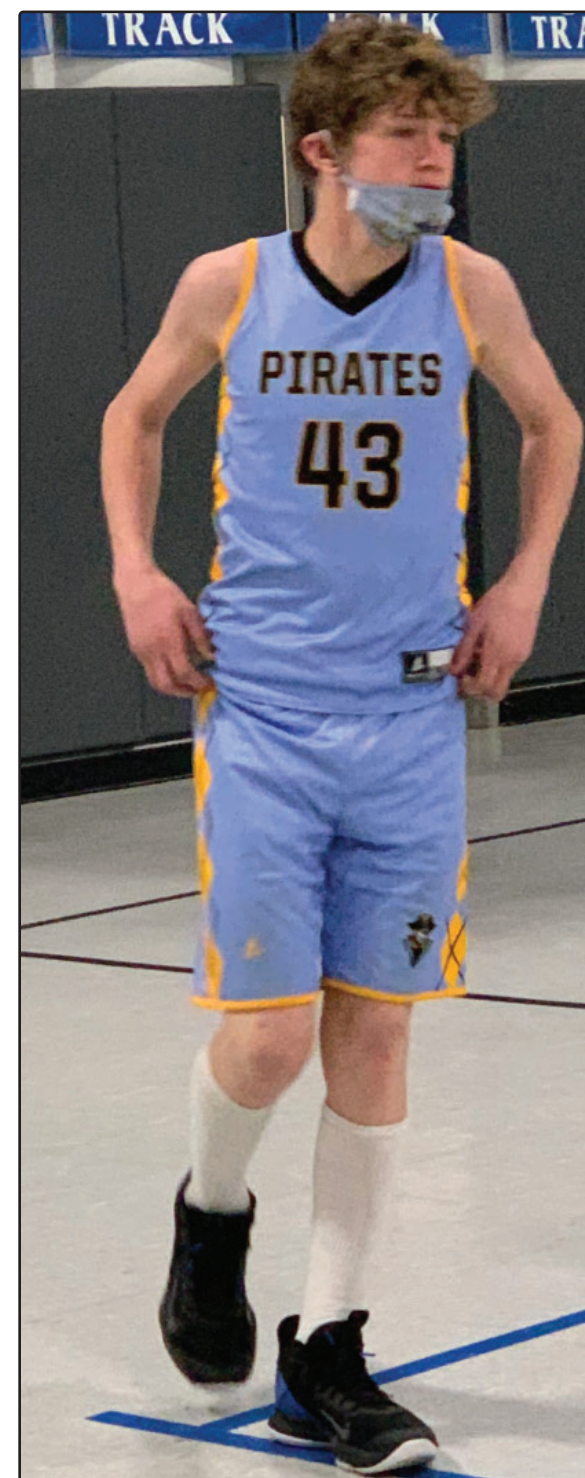

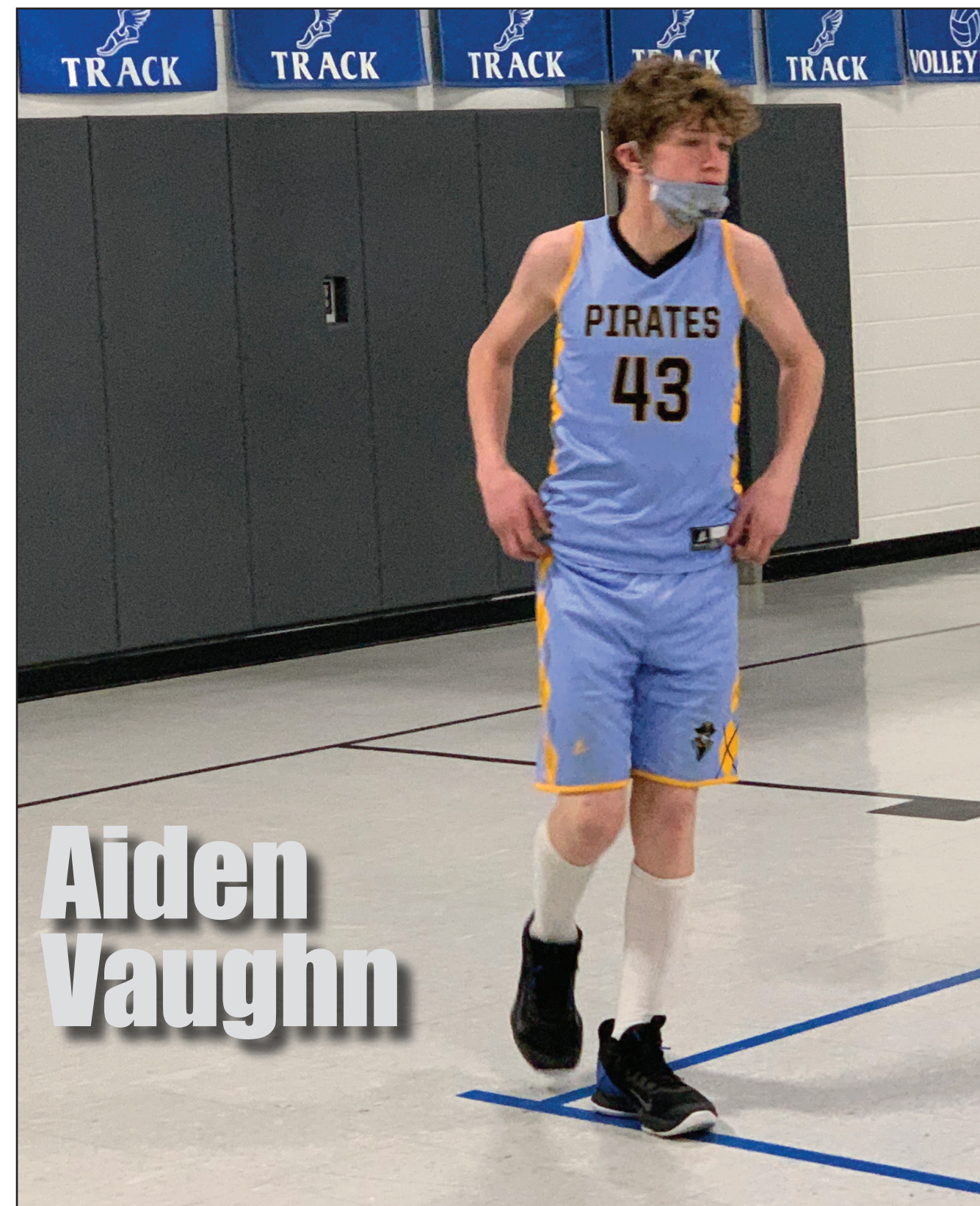
playing some sort of sport he is working on his family farm where he enjoys caring for his chickens and his cow, Jasmine.

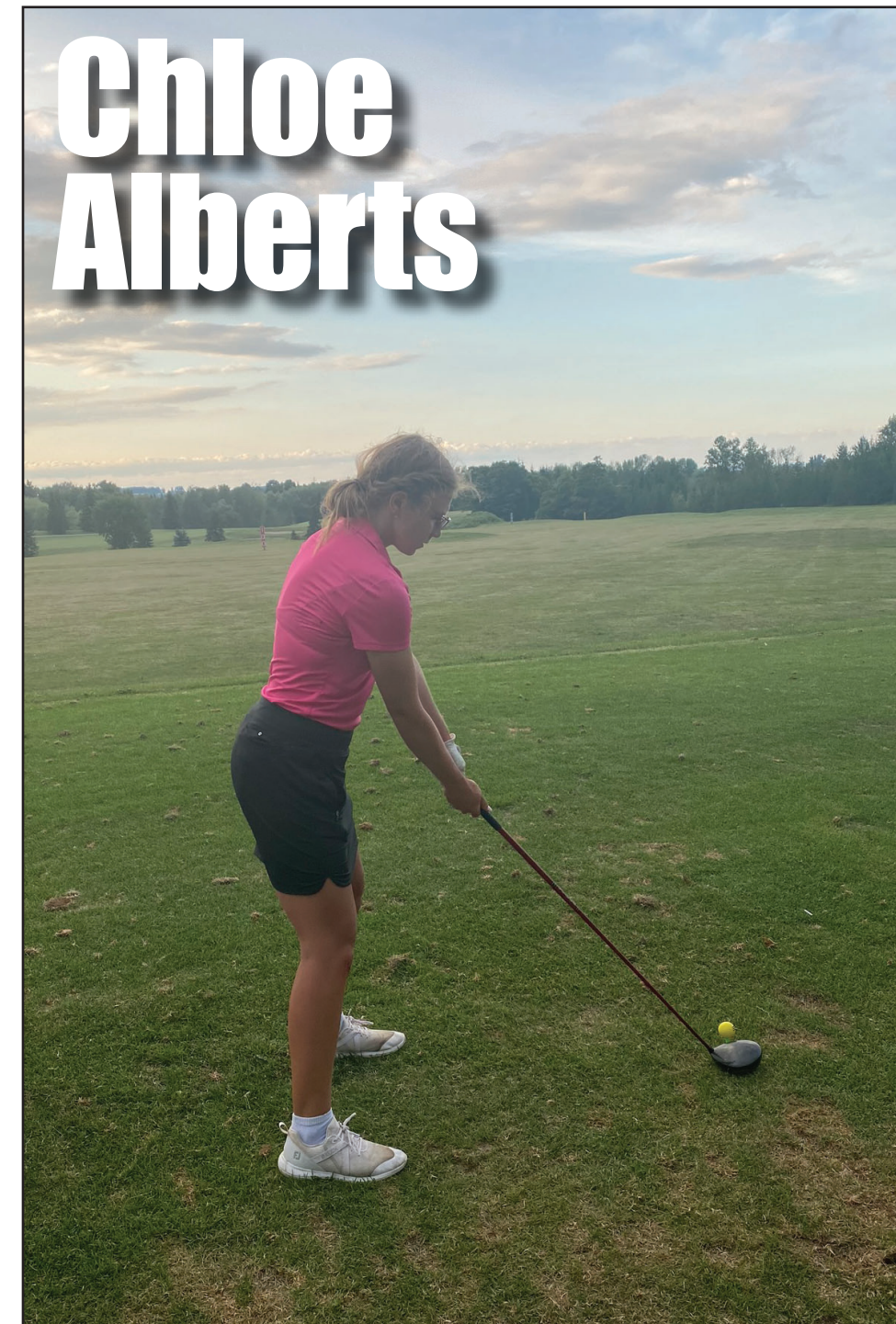
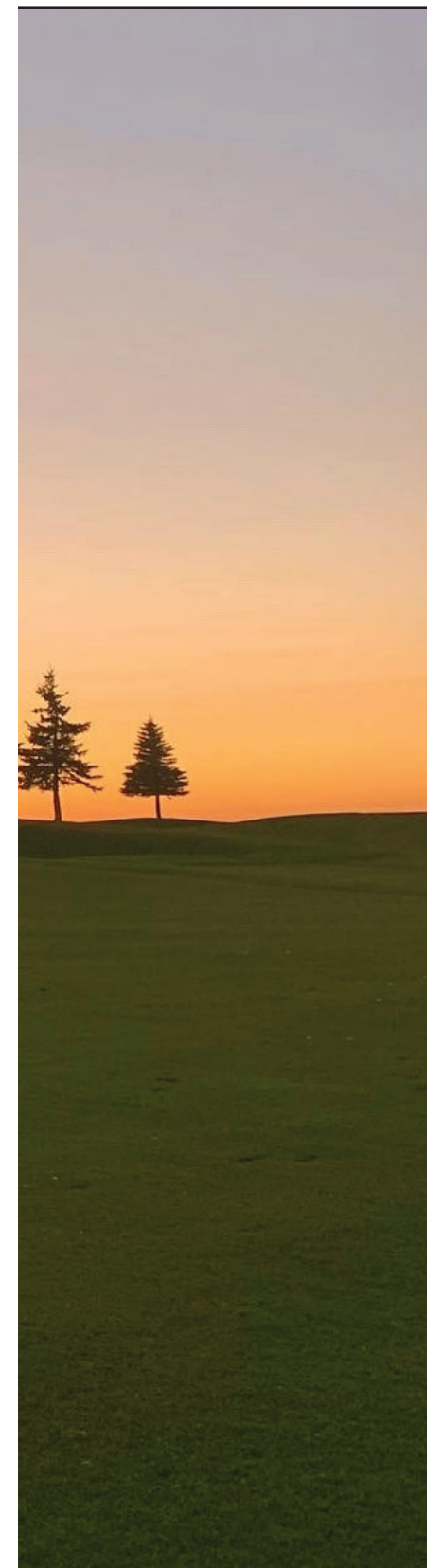
What I am most confident about in golf is the iron

Someday I would like to join the Masters and play against Rory McGilroy. I will work hard for that day.

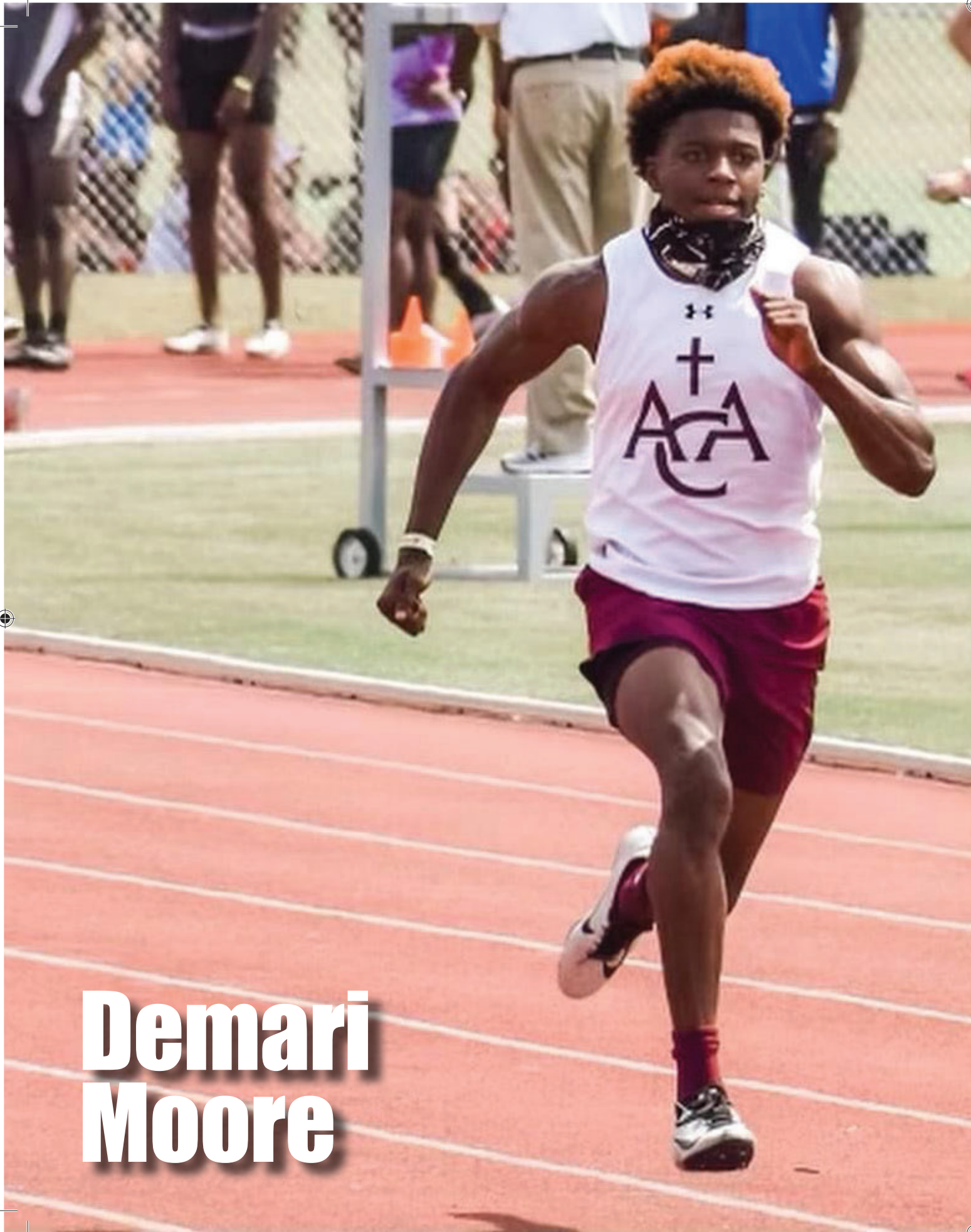
