I work hard each day to become the best technical player that I can, looking to get 1% better every

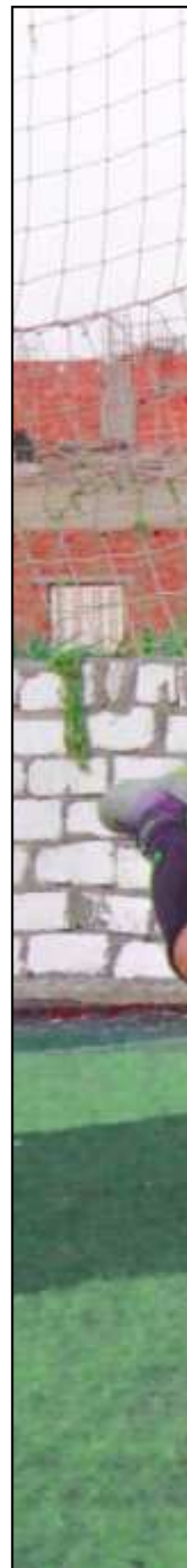
time I train.

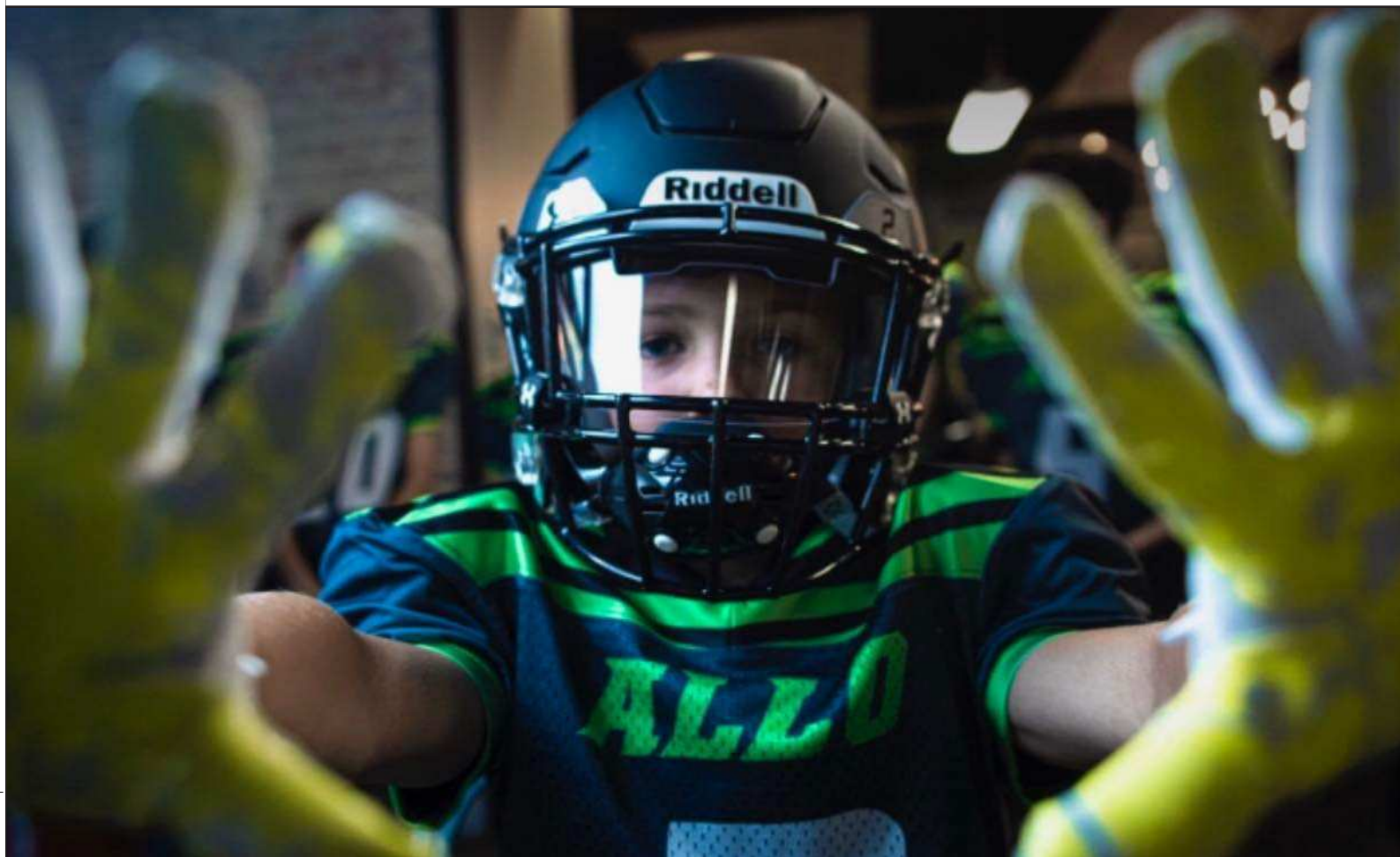

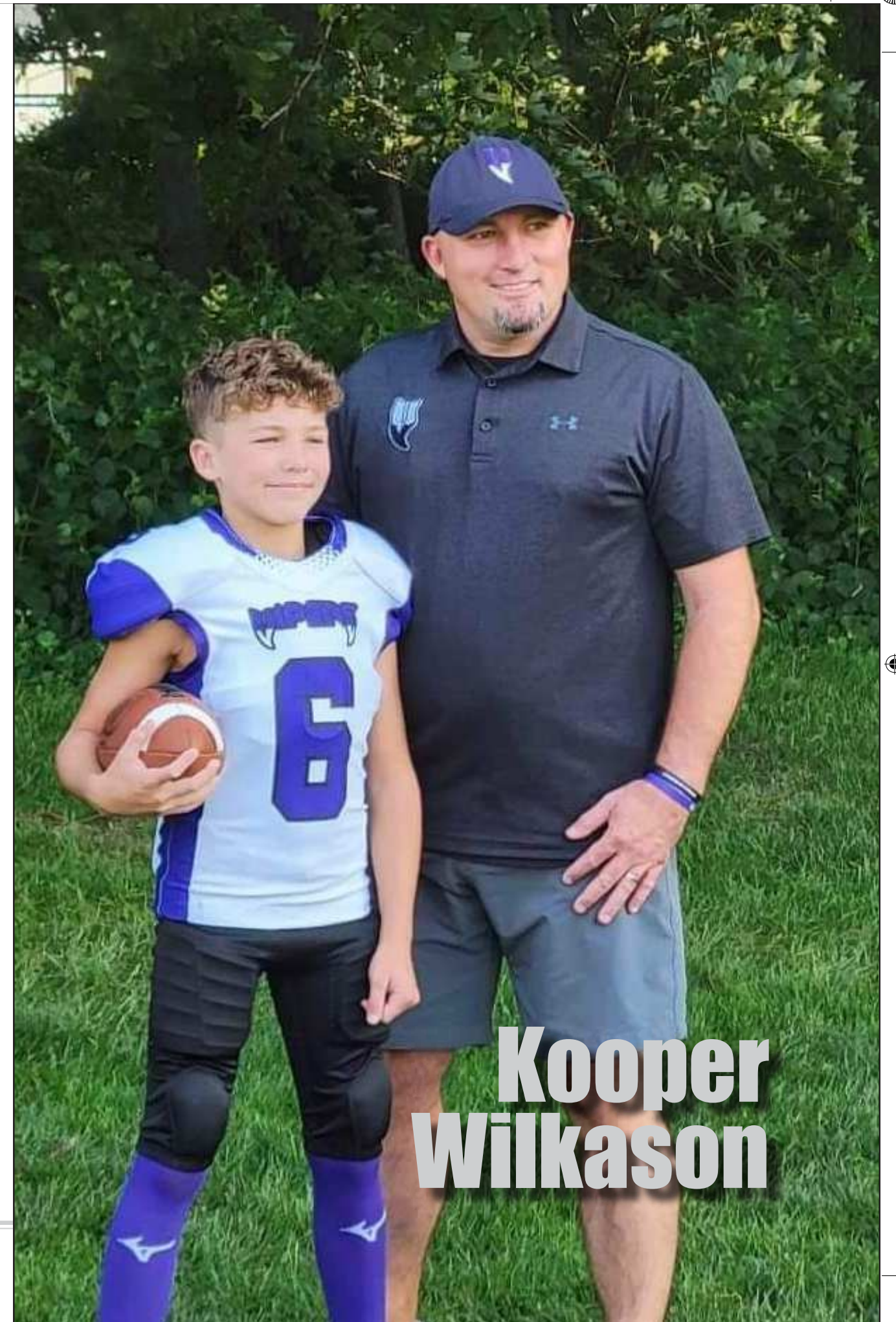

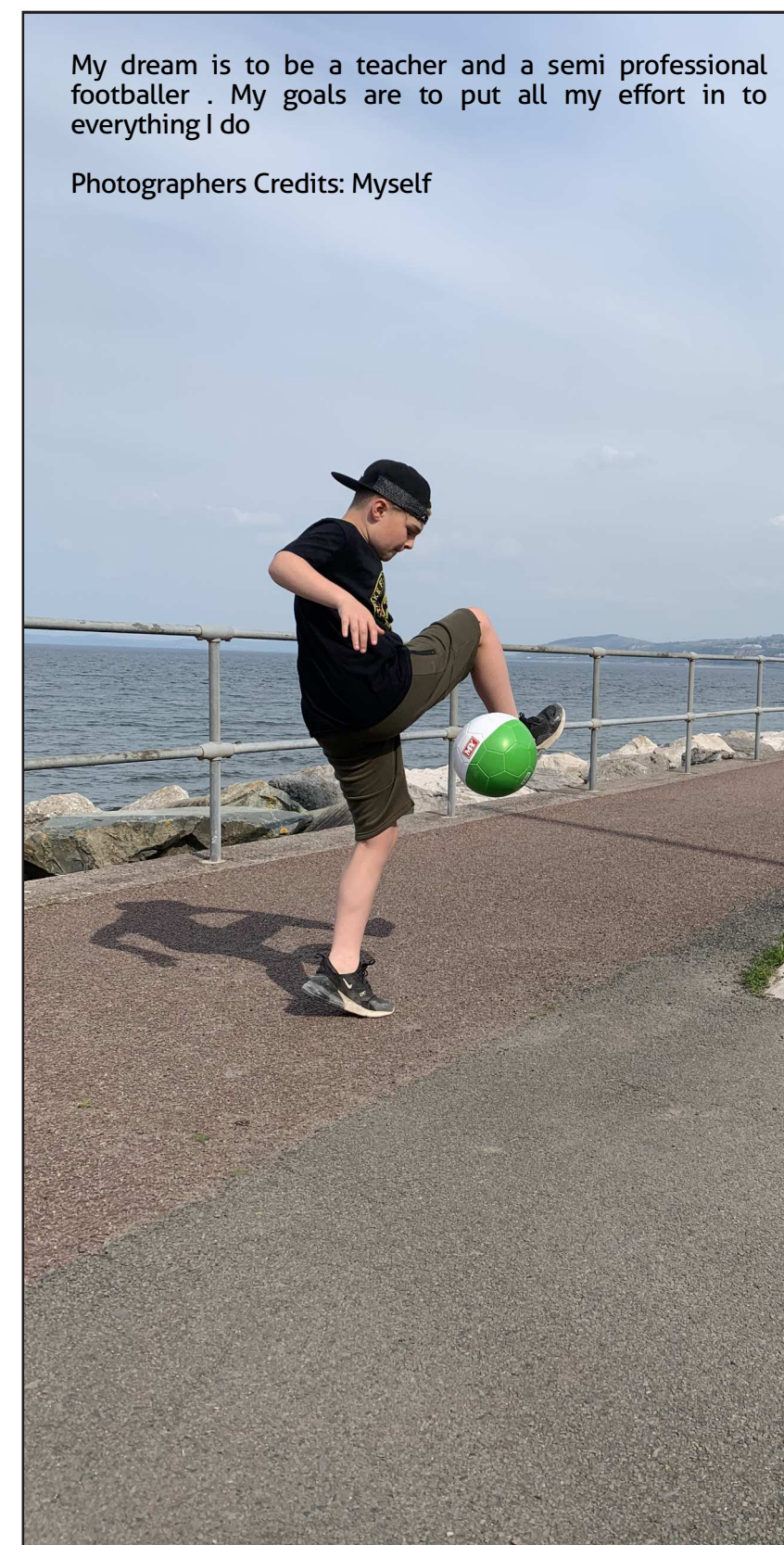
